Question 3: Constitutional Amendment on the Nevada statewide ballot

- Question 3 would dismantle Nevada's existing, regulated electricity system giving the Legislature until July 1, 2023 to pass laws establishing a new, deregulated system
- NV Energy would cease to exist as an electricity provider in Nevada
 - Question 3 would force the company to sell its power plants and cancel long-term energy agreements
 - Financial losses would be passed on to consumers and taxpayers
 - Hundreds of good-paying jobs would be lost


Coalition to Defeat Question 3 Formed

- Coalition was built by a broad, bipartisan coalition of leading Nevada groups/organizations, hundreds of small business, and over 6,500 individuals – led primarily by the AFL-CIO and IBEW
- Coalition members appeared in TV commercials, direct mail pieces, social media, community events and other gatherings across the state
