



Projected Electoral Vote – 34 Votes Remain




County Vote Comparisons – 2020 Land Area



Popular Vote Comparison




County Vote Comparisons – 2020 Population
















U.S. Senate 2020 Results – Democrat Disappointments




Latest US House – **Dems Currently Down Net 5**






Governors Post-2020 Election
